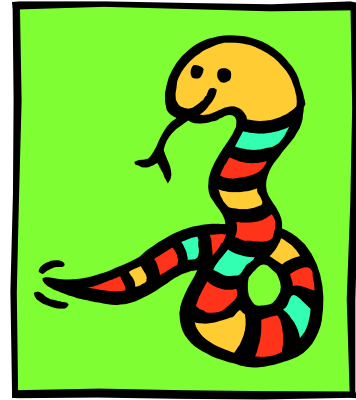


Snakes
